### Stephanie — The Shining Star

On September 15, 1990, Stephanie was injured in a car accident when her seat belt came unlatched and her head hit the windshield. Her neck was twisted and she suffered a concussion. She was referred to Dr. Bobby Doscher at Oklahaven Children's Chiropractic Center by Dr. Terry Taron.

On her first visit, we learned of Stephanie's struggle for life and her physical problems. She had very limited speech but mostly communicated through sign language and gestures. Her face appeared strained, her left eyelid drooped impairing her vision. Her balance was uneven causing her to walk with an abnormal gait, throwing her right leg out and sometimes walking on her tiptoes.

"Stephanie was termed a 'bubble baby' born without any immunities and not expected to live. She showed a phenomenal range of healing capacity. Struggling against insurmountable odds became her goal. She had to be isolated with her mother for the first three years of her life until she began making her own

gamma globulin and nearly died three times before she was a year old," said her mother.

Born December 26, 1969, her mother said, "she was almost a Christmas baby, and definitely our littlest angel, weighing 5 pounds, 11 ounces. She was then and still is a special gift of love from God. To know her is to love her, and to experience God's unconditional love flowing from her."

"At five years of age she had major knee surgery for a permanently dislocated knee cap. At ten years of age she swallowed a needle which perforated her pancreas; another brush with death."

Dr. Doscher found Stephanie to have many spinal misalignments which affected her overall balance and her speech dramatically. Stephanie has continued to progress rapidly from her very first adjustment. Today Stephanie has begun working a forty hour work week and is improving in her speech and all aspects of life...She is thrilled with her new independence and the ability to go to work each day. Her mother said "she is the star that shines even brighter today because of the help she has received from Oklahaven."

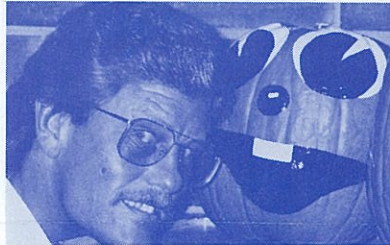

## The Pumpkins were the best yet!!!

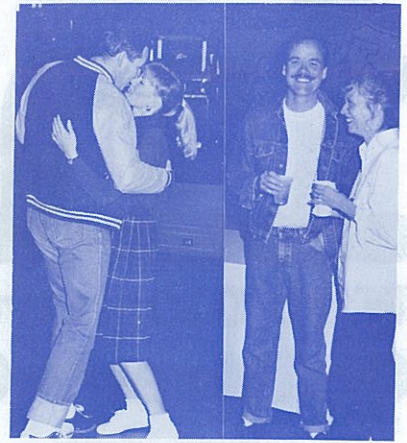
Thank you to everyone who purchased a pumpkin, especially the chiropractic offices. Many patients called so they too could have one and learn more about Chiropractic and children.
