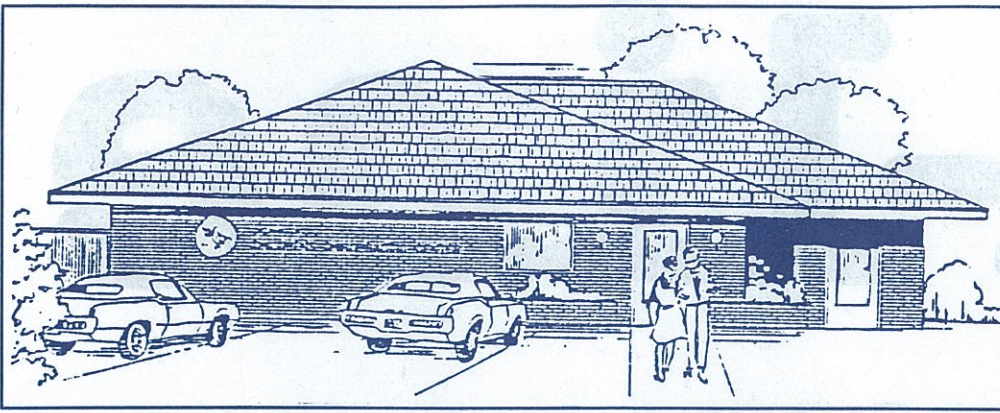


Leah, Robert Groupe, PhD. and Dr. Bobby Doscher.

# HAPPY BIRTHDAY OKLAHAVEN!

August 8, 1962 Oklahaven Children's Chiropractic Center began caring for needy children. Six volunteer chiropractors originally established the center to provide examination and treatment for children. "Our history is full of 'miracle cases' which demonstrate our accomplishments over the last three decades", Doscher stated.

August 8, 1992 marked the beginning of a fourth decade of hope and care for children's good health. Due to our 30 years of success, we have outgrown our present facility. Good news!

Dr. Bobby Doscher, announced plans are underway to acquire an existing building located at 4500 N. Meridian in Oklahoma City. The new center will enable Oklahaven to better serve growing community needs, as well as to increase community education regarding the importance of natural health care for children. Some renovation of the new site will be required and PRSM Architectural Firm of Norman, OK has given the above illustration of the proposed remodeling.

Today, Oklahaven's commitment to providing children with natural, drug-free health care is stronger than ever.

"Our history is full of 'miracle' cases that demonstrate our accomplishments with children over the last three decades", Doscher stated.

Internationally recognized for its success with children, the Center's services range from treating severely handicapped children to providing care for common, childhood disorders, such as colic, colds, asthma and ear problems.

In honor of her contributions to the Center's thirty years of outstanding achievements, Dr. Bobby Doscher, Oklahaven's President and Chief Executive Officer, was presented a proclamation from Oklahoma's governor, David Walters. The governor proclaimed July 25, 1992, "Dr. Bobby Doscher Day" in the state of Oklahoma.

"It was a privilege to receive such an honor," said Doscher, adding, "Over the years, we have helped many children realize their full health potential through chiropractic care, but there is much more that must be done."

## How does chiropractic treatment help asthma and allergies?

As a chiropractor, I believe that the nervous system influences all the organs, glands, tissue and cells of the body either directly or indirectly.

The central nervous system originates in the brain and extends through the spinal column, reaching every major part of the body. It is the life line of the body, with more than 3 million impulses generating in the nervous system every second.
